## Rockwell receives 'consistently high prices' in gem sale

Junior diamond producer Rockwell Diamonds said on Thursday that it had completed diamond tender sales on June 27, for its South African operations, receiving an average price of \$1 888/ct.

The parcel of diamonds tendered included 26 stones greater than 10 ct in weight, with the largest a 48,15 ct stone, from Wouterspan, on the middle Orange river.

"Consistently high prices were received for diamonds from all three of the company's operations, with strong demand and excellent US dollar per carat values being achieved for stones larger than 3 carats," Rockwell said in a statement posted on its website.

The firm, which plans to embark on a secondary listing on the JSE in September, owns the Wouterspan, Holpan and Klipdam operations, which are along the Orange River, west of Kimberley.

Rockwell also said that it was doing test work on the plant at its new Makoenskloof project, where it had built up a stockpile that it would process when the plant was finally commissioned.
